Governing Rules & Policies

Three Eagles Golf Course Authorized Patrons of Facilities

Annual & Daily Green Fee Play

1. Active and Retired members of the Armed Forces and their family members.
2. Current and Retired Civilian employees of the Department of Defense and their family members. I.D. Cards are required.
3. Authorized Department of Defense Contractors
4. Civilian Play. For information on how to obtain a civilian golf pass to gain base access for play at Three Eagles Golf Course, just ask or call the Pro Shop Staff.

Tee Times—(919) 722-0395

Tee Times are always recommended and are required on weekends, holidays, and “down days” prior to noon. Call the Pro Shop or book tee times online at www.sjfss.com (see Golf).

Active Duty may reserve up to seven (7) days in advance. Annual Green Fees holders may reserve up to six (6) days in advance. All other eligible players may reserve up to five (5) days in advance. Civilians may reserve up to three (3) days in advance.

Players with reserved tee times must check in at the Pro Shop no later than 8 minutes prior to the scheduled tee time. Patrons who miss scheduled tee times will be added to the bottom of the waiting list. The Starter will fill vacancies from the top of the waiting list.

Dress and Personal Conduct

During play at Three Eagles Golf Course, a shirt with a collar or “golf shirt” is required to be worn. T-shirts, tank tops, and sport jerseys are not considered proper attire and are unauthorized on the course.

The course endorses and supports the use of soft spikes or spikeless shoes. Running or tennis shoes are also allowed. Shoes with metal spikes are not allowed.

Golf Course Etiquette

All patrons are expected to follow and comply with traditional golf course etiquette.

- Pace of play is very important. Allow faster players to “play through.”
- Improve the condition of the course for the next golfer. Fill or replace divots in the fairways and on tee boxes. Repair ball marks on the greens and rake sand in bunkers back to a smooth surface.
- Motor carts are to be kept on the paths during wet turf conditions and while playing par “3s.”
- Do not ride more than two (2) people in a motor cart at any time.
- If you are new to the game of golf, please ask questions of our staff—we are here to help.

Rules Enforcement

Management and Player Assistants are responsible for enforcing the rules. They have the authority to direct any player to leave the course for infractions of the rules.

Suspension of Privileges

All users of Three Eagles Golf Course are responsible for following the rules of the facility. Violation of the rules will result in suspension of privileges for a period of time commensurate with the severity of the offense.

Other Restrictions

- Bicycles are not allowed on the course or in facilities.
- Alcoholic beverages are not allowed to be brought onto the Three Eagles Golf Course premises.
- Baby strollers are not allowed on the golf course.

Safety

Three Eagles Golf Course is an established hazardous area. An airborne golf ball is a dangerous projectile that has the potential to cause serious injury or death should you get hit by one. Caution should be exercised at all times on the course.

Rain Checks

Rain checks will not be given unless the course is closed for unplayable conditions. Military and family emergencies may also warrant a rain check at the discretion of the golf course manager.
