**"3-Day TAP Workshop"** - DoL sponsored 3-day workshop for all ranks; provides information on VA benefits, civilian employment, resumes, interviews, etc. for those personnel transitioning from the military to the private sector.

**"Bundles for Babies"** is an Air Force Aid Society (AFAS) Program designed to provide expectant parents with quality information and resources and is sponsored jointly by the Airman & Family Readiness Center (A&FRC) staff, Family Advocacy, the Partnership for Children of Wayne County, Officer and Civilian Spouses Club (OCSC), and the Health and Wellness Center. **"Resume Writing"**— Learn the basics on writing the all important Cover Letter, Resume and Reference Sheets.

**"Wing Right Start & Information Fair"** - Wing wide briefing for all newcomers and their families to attend.
