- Request a reservation ONLY if you plan to attend and not if you "might" attend to avoid vacancies.







The Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP) is a mandatory enrollment program that works with other military and civilian agencies to provide comprehensive and coordinated community support, housing, educational, medical, and personnel services to families with special needs. Active duty members enroll in the program when they have a Family member with a physical, emotional, developmental, or intellectual disorder requiring specialized services so their needs can be considered in the military personnel assignment process.

Q: What is the definition of an Exceptional Family Member?

A: An EFM is a family member enrolled in DEERS who has a diagnosed physical, educational, intellectual, emotional, or psychological condition that requires specialized medical or educational services.

Q: Is enrollment in the EFMP mandatory?

A: Yes. Enrollment is mandatory for active duty personnel who have a dependent family member with a special medical or educational need.

Q: How do I enroll in the EFMP?

A: Members can enroll by contacting the EFMP Medical at 919-722-0809.

Q: Will enrollment affect promotion?

A: No. Information about enrollment is not given to selection boards. Enrollment does not adversely affect a service member's selection for promotion, schools or assignments.

Q: Is an Individualized Education Program (IEP) or Individualized Family Services Plan (IFSP) criteria for enrollment?

A: Any Active Duty AF sponsor that has a child with an IEP or that has an IFSP must be enrolled in AF EFMP; however, plans are not required for enrollment.

EFMP is the Air Force Exceptional Family Member Program.

FS stands for Family Support. The EFMP-FS is available to ensure that each family receives comprehensive coordinated support through the military and/or civilian community.
